



Dear Parents or Group Leaders,

**Thank You:** Choosing the right camp is important and we thank you for choosing Horizons Camp for Girls at Mundo Vista. 2019 is our 51st summer of offering Christian girls summer camps with an emphasis on missions. **Values:** We use fun to pursue four values. Our values are 'growing faith in Jesus, developing relationships, building life skills, and serving others through missions.' We use our fun camp experience to facilitate opportunities for campers to better know Jesus Christ, connect with others, take home teachable moments, and to get excited about sharing their faith in Jesus.

**Program:** Our staff have been carefully screened, trained, and equipped to serve your children well. We care about the safety and well-being of your children, and will do our best to serve them well. The girls will be grouped with other girls their age. Campers will be encouraged to participate and do their best in each activity, but the level of participation is always the choice of the camper. We want you to be as well informed as possible. Please contact us with questions.

As we reflect from our most iconic location on our campus, the outdoor chapel, we see the beauty of God's creation expanding into the horizon. The vision of Horizon's camp is for each person who attends camp to encounter God in a new way that will expand their horizons physically, relationally, and spiritually to be who God is creating them to be.

**Recreation:** Depending on age campers may have the opportunity to participate in recreation such as swimming, zip line, archery, air rifles, games, and more. Camp activity skill choices may include: model rocketry, photography, key log rolling, outdoor cooking, painting, ukulele, and dance. Camp activity sign ups will be done on the first day.

**Required Forms:** In a different document are health history forms, a medication form, and a waiver form. Please bring these forms to check in at camp completed with accurate information and signed by the custodial guardian on the health history form and the waiver form. If someone else is bringing your child, please be sure that the guardian who transports them has the completed forms and medications with them. The medication form (only if needed) is to document medication that the camper needs while she is here, whether it is an over the counter or a prescription medication. **The custodial parent or guardian must be the one to sign all of the forms.**



**Pairing Up information:** We allow up to 4 girls that are friends of the same age range to pair together. The age groups are 9-11 year olds; 12-13 year olds; and 14-17 year olds. Pairing requests should be made by emailing Linda Hollingsworth at least 2 weeks in advance: [mundovista@caraway.org](mailto:mundovista@caraway.org). Please include the session #, each camper's full name, and date of birth.

**Arrival:** Check-in is between 3-4pm on your registered start date. See check in information below. After check in we invite parents and guardians as an option to accompany their daughter to her cabin for a brief visit to meet her counselor. You may then choose to visit The Canteen, our camp store.

**Check-in:** Included in this document are directions to our campus. Once on our property, follow the Check-In signs. A staff person will direct you to the luggage drop off location and then show you where to park. After parking you will walk to the Centennial building with forms and medications for check in and a staff member will lead you to your daughter's cabin after check in.

Please bring all camper forms and medication with you to check in after you park your car. **To help reduce check in time, please have all forms in this order attaching them with a paper clip, not a staple: cover sheet, signed waiver form, signed health history forms, completed medication form (only if needed), and all medications including daily over the counter medications.** \*Thank you for not printing on both sides of the page as some documents are not stored together. If your child does have medications, please put all medications in a durable zip bag with their name and age written in permanent marker visible on the bag. After check in you may say good bye to your campers if you choose or you may accompany them to their cabin for a brief visit.

**Pick up:** Join us on the last day for our closing program celebration before you sign out your camper. We will share briefly about what has happened during the week and we will watch the DVD from that session. Please arrive between **10:30-10:45a.m.** The program will start at 10:45a.m. We welcome you to stay for an optional lunch after you check out your camper. **Campers may not leave before the closing program unless prior arrangements have been made.** If any different pick-up arrangements need to be made, we must be notified one week in advance and it must be documented on the waiver form.

**Pick Up Day Lunch:** Please RSVP for pick up day lunch at check in or email your number eating to [mundovista@caraway.org](mailto:mundovista@caraway.org) by noon the day before. The cost of eating lunch with us is \$5 per person ages 12 and up, \$3 per person ages 3-11, and ages 0-2 is free. Please pay with exact cash or check at the lunch line making the check out to Camp Caraway. The cost of lunch for your camper is included in her registration fee. This meal is a fun optional time for you to talk to your son and meet his camp counselor and some of our staff while enjoying lunch together. The canteen, our camp store will be open for purchases after check out.



**Warrior Camp at Caraway:** If you have girls here at Mundo Vista and Boys at [Caraway](#), please attend the closing program at Mundo Vista at 10:45am first, then go to Caraway for their closing program that starts at 12. We anticipate each closing program lasting up to 45 minutes. We will allow parents who need to go to Caraway from Mundo Vista the opportunity to check out their girls first.

**Contacting Campers:** If you wish to contact your child throughout the week we encourage you to write a letter or post card and bring it with you to check-in, and we can give it to him later in the week. You may also mail a letter the week before he comes to ensure it arrives on time. The address is 3140 Camp Mundo Vista Trail Sophia, NC 27350. Please include the camper's age on the envelope.

Through our partner Bunk 1 you may send your camper a free basic e-mail or purchase credits to enhance the e-mail or purchase a reply for your camper to complete to be returned to you. You may also download their App to do this on your device and to receive notifications when we post pictures. See the details below on the Bunk 1 page.

**Pictures:** We invite you to keep up with our week by liking us on Facebook: [www.facebook.com/cmvetreatcenter](http://www.facebook.com/cmvetreatcenter). Only a few pictures will be posted on Facebook. We will load *all* daily photos on Bunk1.com. You must log in to Bunk 1 or download the Bunk1 App to view the photos. *There is no guarantee that your camper's picture will be posted daily.* See more on the Bunk 1 page below.

**Emergency Contact:** Campers are not allowed to have cell phones or smart watches. We will keep you well informed if needed, and can deliver any important messages to your camper if necessary. We will call you using the numbers you provided in the health form any time we have concerns about your child's health or behavior. Thank you for not sending cell phones with your camper. Between 9am-2pm Mon-Fri. call us at 336-521-9209. Any other day or time, call the summer camp office number at 336-521-9207. We check messages multiple times throughout the day and welcome your call.

**Money:** For session 1, the camp counselor will collect the camper's money and carry it in a bag and will distribute it when they need it. For session 2, the camp counselor will assist them with the money if needed and let them know when to bring it. This money needs to be in a durable zip bag labeled with her full name and age written in permanent marker. He will have the opportunity to visit The Canteen and game room daily to purchase optional Camp Mundo Vista gifts and snacks.

We will also receive an optional missions offering to teach the importance of giving. \$50-60 should be enough money your daughter will need for the entire week. Parents/leaders can make purchases at our camp store during drop off and pick up.



**The Canteen:** The Canteen will be open during check in and after pick up for parents. Store items approximate costs: Snacks & Drinks (\$1-\$2 each), New Camp Mundo Vista T-shirts (\$10), Shorts (\$15), Camp Mundo Vista Hats (\$10), Camp DVDs highlighting your daughter's session of camp (\$12), New water bottles (\$10 or 15), Necklaces (\$10), Bracelets (\$5), Toys – (\$5), Stuffed Animals (\$6-12), and much more.

**Lost & Found:** Please label every item your child packs with their name. There is a lost and found box in the dining hall for campers and their camp counselors to check at each meal. We will also place lost and found items on a table at check out. To mail a lost item back to you will cost a \$5 handling fee plus the cost of the postage for the item.

**Special Concerns:** Our staff are trained to approach special concerns with campers such as medical conditions, bed wetting, or home sickness with the utmost respect and confidentiality. You can help us prepare your daughter for success with these needs.

*Medical Conditions:* Please document all medical conditions, needed medications, and other pertinent information on the health history form. If needed, please share any clarifications or special concerns with us at the medication check in table on Monday. If your child has any special food needs document this on the health history form and please contact me the week before her camp arrival so we can make arrangements to serve her best.

*Bedwetting:* Document this on the health history form so the camp counselor will be prepared for the possibility to assist your daughter. We suggest you consider pull up absorbent overnight underwear or disposable bed linen covers. Both of these can be discreetly used. If a girl does soil her bed our staff will discreetly wash the linens and clothes and give the girl reassurance and support as needed.

*Homesickness:* Homesickness is normal and many campers may experience a little homesickness at some point during their camp session. Parents can help with homesickness with patience and preparation. Please consider some of these tips to help your camper deal with homesickness in a healthy way at camp: Encourage your child's independence throughout the year, Such as being away from home for trips or sleepovers at a friend's house; Discuss what camp will be like before you leave and call us with questions; Please honor our no cell phone policy, we will call you if needed and you can call us as needed; Send your camper a letter or e-mail throughout the week; Please do not bribe, linking a successful stay at camp to a material object may send the wrong message. Your child's confidence and independence will be a great reward for completing a week at camp. During the week, if you are worried about how your daughter is adjusting please call us and speak to us about your daughter. We will gladly check on your daughter for you, and don't feel guilty about encouraging your daughter to stay at camp. Camp can be a great first step towards independence and can play an important role in the growth and development of your child.



**Behavior & Bullying:** Campers are given clear expectations and rules for the week when they arrive. We expect campers to follow these expectations and to treat each other as they want to be treated. Our staff are trained well in motivating and disciplining campers appropriately. Bullying or picking of any kind is inexcusable and not tolerated here. If your child does not follow our expectations and rules after disciplinary action, we will call you and will likely send your child home if they do not respond to our expectations promptly.

## **Camp Mundo Vista Summer 2019 Payment Policies**

Thank you for choosing to attend a summer program at Camp Mundo Vista! These policies are for Horizon's Camp for Girls and Me, Mom, and Chocolate Mother-Daughter Retreats.

- **Registration-** You may register online at [www.campmundovista.com](http://www.campmundovista.com) with a credit card. Registration is first come-first serve. We will post online when any camps are full.
- **Contact:** Connect with Linda Hollingsworth with any registration or payment needs: [lhollingsworth@caraway.org](mailto:lhollingsworth@caraway.org) or 336-521-9209.
- **Deposit-** A \$75 per person nonrefundable deposit is due immediately upon registration.
- **Balance-** The full balance due deadline is 4 weeks before the starting day of your camp unless otherwise noted.
- **Refunds-** Deposits are non-refundable. Balances are non-refundable except in the event of illness, injury, or death in the immediate family. Contact Linda with these needs.
- **Reducing numbers when registering as a group-** Dropping numbers before the balance due deadline will lose the \$75 per person deposit and is not transferable to your balance. Any drops made after the balance due deadline will result in losing those deposits and an additional \$75 per person fee.
- **Raising numbers when registering as a group-** First, check with us to be sure we have availability before promising a spot to someone. To increase numbers before the balance due deadline, the deposits for the increase are due on the day of increase. If you increase in number after the balance due deadline, the full balance for those additions will be due on the day of increase.

## **Camp Camp Mundo Vista for girls Packing List**

Please Label all items with the camper's name

- ❑ Bible
- ❑ Small light weight school type back pack to carry water bottle, money, flashlight, etc.
- ❑ Clothes (t-shirts & shorts) enough to last the week
- ❑ Favorite sports team jersey for Thursday night (optional)
- ❑ 1 pair of long pants
- ❑ Underclothes
- ❑ Twin sheets & blanket or a sleeping bag (we will provide a sleeping bag for the overnight campout experience)
- ❑ Pillow
- ❑ 3 towels and a wash cloth
- ❑ Toiletry articles (toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, soap, etc.)
- ❑ Insect repellent
- ❑ Sunscreen
- ❑ Tennis shoes (should be close toed shoes that can get dirty)
- ❑ Shower shoes (girls ages 14 & up may have a short walk to their bath house)
- ❑ 1 Light weight rain coat or poncho
- ❑ 2 Large breathable dirty clothes bags (1 for dirty clothes and 1 for wet clothes)
- ❑ 1 Light jacket or sweatshirt
- ❑ 1 Pair of pajamas or sleep wear
- ❑ 1 Bathing suit
- ❑ Flashlight with extra batteries
- ❑ Water bottle (we do not provide cups at water coolers)
- ❑ Letter writing supplies
- ❑ Store and missions offering money in a plastic zip bag labeled with their name and age

### **What Not To Bring**

- Any electronics, mobile phones, tablets, etc.
- Any animals or pets
- Fireworks of any kind
- Firearms or weapons
- Any type of illegal drugs, tobacco, vapes, or alcohol
- Thank you for not sending any food to camp with your daughter. If special arrangements for snacks need to be made for medical readaughters, please make this known at check in.
- Vehicles (unless pre-approved by the director)
- Perdaughteral recreation or athletic equipment is not allowed

Camp Mundo Vista is located in Randolph County, North Carolina.  
We are about 7 miles west of Asheboro in the community of Sophia.

**FROM RALEIGH:**

- Take 64 West to Asheboro
- Take I-73 North toward Greensboro  
(also called 220 bypass North, Not 220 Business North).
- Get in the left lane as the exit will be a left exit.
- Proceed 1 ¼ miles and take the first exit, "Asheboro Hwy 42".
- At the end of the exit ramp, turn Left onto Old Lexington Rd.
- Proceed 5 miles, bear Rt. at Speedway sign, onto Caraway Mtn. Rd.
- Follow Caraway Mountain Road for 2 miles and
- The Camp Mundo Vista entrance will be on your left.

**FROM CHARLOTTE/LEXINGTON:**

- From I-85 North, take Exit 96 (Hwy 64 East, Zoo) toward Asheboro.
- Go 17 miles to flashing caution light.
- Turn Left onto Spenser Meadow Rd (Amity Hills Church on left).
- Drive 2 miles to stop sign.
- Turn Right onto Old Lexington Rd
- Drive a tenth of a mile to Green Farm Rd.
- Turn Left onto Green Farm Rd
- Drive 2 miles to flashing light at the intersection of Caraway Mtn. Rd.
- Turn Left onto Caraway Mountain Road and drive 2 miles.
- The Camp Mundo Vista entrance is on the left.

**FROM GREENSBORO:**

- From I-40 or I-85, take 220/I-73 South
- Take Hwy 42 Exit at Asheboro
- Turn Right (West) onto Old Lexington Rd.
- Proceed 5 miles, bear Right at Speedway sign onto Caraway Mtn. Rd.
- Follow Caraway Mountain Rd for 2 miles.
- The Camp Mundo Vista entrance will be on your left.

**FROM ASHEBORO:**

- From 220 Bypass/I-73 (North) take Hwy 42 exit. This is a LEFT exit.
- At the end of the exit ramp, turn Left (West) onto Old Lexington Rd.
- Proceed 5 miles, bear Right at Speedway sign onto Caraway Mtn. Rd.
- Follow Caraway Mountain Rd for 2 miles.
- The Camp Mundo Vista entrance will be on your left.

**FROM HIGH POINT:**

- Take 311 South.
- After passing Fairfield Dr. & Planet Fitness, bear right onto Archdale Rd.
- Follow this road for approx. 14 miles through various name changes.
- This road becomes Caraway Mountain Rd.
- The Camp Mundo Vista entrance will be on your right.



### PHOTO GALLERY WITH FACIAL RECOGNITION
